### ELA

I am excited to get started in ELA. Students will learn, grow, be challenged and have fun. All while reading and writing!

Eighth grade will be working hard on their Elder projects this entire school year. They will also be following the theme of "Who I Want to Become" this year.

Seventh grade is getting into the flow of class and learning routines. The seventh grade theme this year is "Who I Am."

Students will be reading 3 books outside of class each marking period. Remember, all students should be reading each day at home!

### Social Studies

Welcome to Social Studies! This is a two year course covering American history. Eighth grade will pick up where they left off last year.

Seventh grade has started a pre-unit on basic social studies skills. They are also working on memorizing all 50 states. Ask them to sing you the song!

Eighth grade will be starting their stock market project. They will choose and buy their stocks and will be monitoring them over the next few months to see if they can make some money!

### Math

Welcome back to school! I am excited for the start of another amazing year in math! I am thrilled to be able to offer two advanced courses this year. Brand new this year is Algebra I, which is a regents-level course typically taken in 9<sup>th</sup> grade. Accelerated 7<sup>th</sup> grade math includes all of the curriculum from 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade combined into one year at a very rapid pace.

All students in 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade have been asked to conduct a Cultural Math Interview with an adult in their family. This activity is designed to highlight the math that people use in their everyday lives (hobbies, jobs, home, etc.), so that students can develop a more personal connection to math. We are all mathematicians in our own way, even if we haven't realized it yet!

### Science

Welcome September! We are back!! Hello to all parents, guardians and students at ONS. Teachers, like students, return with mixed emotions...we will miss summer, but we are excited to learn and teach new information, skills and curriculum. Science 7 studies will still be mostly focused on Physical Science: Matter, Energy, Chemistry, Motion, Light, Sound, and other Forces in our world. Science 8 will be mostly focused on the Living Parts of our world: Ecosystems, Interactions of Living Things, Taking Care of our World, Cells, Genetics and Climate Change.
