

Graduation Requirements

The Board of Education minimum standards and the New York State Regents minimum standards are required for graduation from high school.

All school programs have one main purpose even though they provide a variety of experience to students. This purpose is to help all students develop and acquire the skills, abilities, knowledge, and attitudes necessary to work towards high school graduation. Eligibility of a student for a High School or a New York State Regents Diploma will be determined by the high school principal on the basis of the official high school record. Students who meet the requirements may be issued a diploma.
