1. Type text you want to appear on your web page. Highlight the text.
2. Click the Internet Link icon in the tool bar. This makes a popup window appear.
3. Type in or paste in the internet address of the site where you wish your link to go.
4. Click the OK button.
5. SAVE and VIEW your change. Test the link to make sure you have it done correctly.
