Roofing, Skylights, Window Insulation, Masonry


Building Systems

- Cafeteria Vision Window




































Project Cost by Component

TYPICAL ANTICIPATED COSTS FOR A CAPITAL PROJECT FUNDING:

When creating a budget for a Capital Project, certain fixed and anticipated costs must be accounted for:

- Design Contingency
- Construction Contingency
- Incidentals (Soft Costs)

Architectural/Engineering Professional Services

Construction Administration/Construction Management Services

Soils, Surveys, Testing and Monitoring

Furniture, Fixtures & Equipment (FF&E)

Legal Fees

Insurances

Bonding Costs

Printing & Reproduction Expenses

Other

Escalation Factor
